Under the Selective Tendering procedures of NSW Public Works, limited numbers of prequalified contractors are invited to tender.

Attention is drawn to NSW Public Works policy whereby any tenderer may be requested to provide additional technical, management and financial information when tenders are being evaluated.

How the System Works

A panel of contractors is selected from the listing available from NSW Public Works – Contractor & Consultant Management System (CCMS). The selection will be based primarily on previous contract performance with the most highly ranked contractors being given preference regarding opportunities to tender.

When the contractor is invited to tender, the invitation will be in the form of a facsimile. The contractor will have up to 48 hours generally to accept or decline the invitation to tender.

After contractor acceptance to tender, one hard copy of the tender document may be made available to you, free of charge. Electronic copies may be downloaded from NSW Public Works eTendering website at https://tenders.nsw.gov.au/dfs.

Having accepted an invitation, each contractor is expected to submit a competitive tender. Failure to submit may result in a negative performance report. Repeated submissions of spurious/non-competitive tenders may also attract a negative performance report. Each contract let will be subject to a Contractor Performance Report (CPR) prepared by NSW Public Works staff, a copy of which will also be given to the contractor.

Tenders must be submitted in the company or firm name as indicated above. You must advise the Prequalification Governance Committee of any significant change in the status of the firm as it occurs, including any substantial change in ownership or financial capacity.

This registration will lapse on 31st December 2013 unless revoked or extended by NSW Public Works.
